Lecture-only classes, writing-intensive or substantial project (No sections; GE writing or ≥10 page papers: 'substantial project' is a project that comprises at least 25% of the total course grade and requires input from faculty/TA's over more than one class meeting for organization, planning, implementation, and/or evaluation/grading of student work
